

RoHS Declaration of Conformity

Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Union on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS) comes into force on July 21, 2011, and was updated with directive 2015/863 on March 31, 2015, and changed with directive 2017/2102 on November 15, 2017. The first six applied to the original RoHS while the last four were added under RoHS 3, which took effect July 22, 2019.

The substances in question are (with maximum concentration values tolerated by weight percentage in homogeneous materials).
